A likely suspect is William Oetjen, but the alleged acts involve removable stickers, usually placed on temporary cardboard signage belonging to Parks & Rec, and won't pass muster as "property damage" as required by 13 V.S.A. § 3701. Nothing further at this time.

Additional note: Municipal Code 21-29 "Graffiti and defacement of property" includes language pertinent to adhesive labels and goes further than 13 VSA 3701. 21-29 includes defacement that is "otherwise affixed" and lists "gum label" as a graffiti implement. Furthermore, it notes that graffiti defacement is the "application to any surface of public or private property of ... other substance".

While we do not currently (as of Jun 28 2021) have probable cause for a ticket or citation against the current POI, I believe there is sufficient evidence to comprise reasonable suspicion, and thereby support a field interview if necessary. More to follow.

On the above date and time, I responded to North Avenue to a report of vandalism that had occurred in the parking lot of North Avenue. Upon arrival, I met with the caller, William J. Oetjen. Oetjen advised that he had parked his Pontiac Vibe bearing VT registration in the North Avenue parking lot for a sporting event. He advised that he was parked in the third spot to the right of the access point to the sporting fields. Oetjen advised that between the hours of 1730 and 2000, someone had poured suntan lotion on the rear-window and top of his vehicle and had removed a customized magnet from his car (see photos). The magnet that was stolen was described as black with white font, that said "Women's Spaces in Sports For Women". Oetjen advised the magnet is valued at approximately \$5.00. Oetjen also advised that the area was busy as there were other sporting events occurring at the same time.

07/21 - Hannaford staff advised that while cameras may have covered the area in which the theft occurred, the footage quality is so poor, one would not be able to not identify a suspect. Case closed pending further evidence, witnesses, or information. Nothing further at this time.

07/23 - Received an e-mail from the records department. Records advised they received a supplemental report from Oetjen containing the following message: "A friend who monitors social media sent me a screenshot of a suspicious post on facebook that identified my car, along with a photo of it, and my home location. It also contained the message, 'it would be terrible if something happened to that car.' The name of the person posting it is in the screenshot. I would like to forward the image if you could give me an e-mail address or text #. Thanks again." E-mail sent to Oetjen requesting screen shot of the post and other relevant information.

07/24 - Oetjen provided me with with screen shots of the Facebook post (see attached), coming from a profile with the name of . The post showed a picture of Oetjen's vehicle and had a caption of "I hope nothing terrible happens to this persons car parked in a driveway on North Ave near the belt line. That would be awful!" Oetjen also provided me with further information regarding , including his employment (UVM) and contact information. Information attached to this case.

07/28 - Discussed case with supervisor, Lt. LaBarge. At this time, there are no direct threats of physical harm to the caller from either the theft of the magnet or the Facebook post and there is no substantive evidence of a crime. There is also no direct evidence that suggests the post and the theft were related. This case is closed at this time.

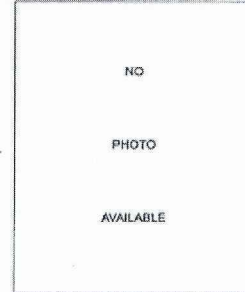
