Dear Defense Counsel,

This notice is provided pursuant to the State's discovery obligation under V.R.Cr.P. 16, Brady v. Maryland, 363 U.S. 83 (1963), and Giglio v. United States, 405 U.S. 150 (1972).

The Windsor County State's Attorney's Office has received information indicating that Hartford Police Sgt. Kristinnah Adams gave a supervisor untruthful information about her whereabouts during a recent patrol shift. We believe this information to be credible and are disclosing it immediately, though a full investigation into the matter has not yet been completed. Given the facts currently available, a preponderance of the evidence suggests that Sgt. Adams was called to respond as back-up to an incident and took an unusually long time to arrive on scene, and then gave a supervisor an explanation that does not appear to be supported by the facts. We have further been notified that Sgt. Adams made a fictitious illness report for a scheduled work shift on February 6, 2018.
