Dear Defense Counsel,

This notice is provided pursuant to the State's discovery obligation under V.R.Cr.P. 16, *Brady v. Maryland*, 363 U.S. 83 (1963), and *Giglio v. United States*, 405 U.S. 150 (1972).

The Windsor County State's Attorney's Office has received information that in November of 2017, while working as a Springfield Police Officer, Logan Defelice may have been untruthful with a fellow officer regarding his efforts to assist in locating a missing suspect. Officer Defelice left the department in 2017 shortly after this incident.

While Springfield Police did investigate the matter (see attached PDFs titled Logan Defelice Memos 1, 2, and 3, as well as Logan Defelice SPD Letter), Chief Doug Johnston did not provide our office with this information at the time. While Officer Defelice has not been a police officer in Springfield for several years, and appears to have relocated to Florida, now that our office has learned of this issue (see Logan Defelice SPD Letter), we are providing this notice and these documents.

Our office is continuing to review old cases to identify cases where Officer Defelice may be listed as a State witness. Kindly contact me directly if you have any questions or concerns about this information. Please note, however, that my office does not employ Logan Defelice and consequently does not maintain a personnel file on him. The attached PDFs constitute the entirety of documentation our office possesses on this matter.
