I have penned this letter pursuant to *Brady v. Maryland*, 363 U.S. 83 (1963), and *Giglio v. United States*, 405 U.S. 150 (1972).

In the pending matter of State of Vermont v. Dylan Lamere, Docket No. 22-CR-06159, I have reviewed the <u>Information by State's Attorney</u> and the <u>VSP Affidavit of Det. Sgt. Henry Alberico</u>. I see that on July 19, 2022, Vermont Superior Court Judge A. Gregory Rainville found probable cause on (i) Careless & Negligent Operation, 23 V.S.A. § 1091(a); and (ii) False Information to a Law Enforcement Officer, 13 V.S.A. § 1754(a). Given the nature of the latter charge, together with the facts alleged, both of which are supported by bodycam and the absence of any motor vehicle accident (for which Tpr. Lamere was never called out for), I am therefore unwilling to call him as a witness. Furthermore, my office will not accept any criminal cases from him from this point forward.
