
### Narrative

On 06/11/19 at approximately 1900 hours I responded to 133 Broad Acres Drive for the report of a 911 open line with a hysterical woman in the background. Upon my arrival on scene I located Lydia Diamond sitting in her vehicle. Diamond appeared to be very emotional and was unable to form a sentence. I spoke with employees of Broad Acres who advised that a few days prior, **Data of the probability of the sentence** advised that Diamond had met with her earlier in the evening to exchange insurance information. **Data of the sentence** advised that Diamond move her car because it was impeding the flow of traffic in the parking lot. Temer advised that Diamond became very unhappy. Temer advised Diamond that if she was going to create a disturbance, then she was not allowed to play bingo that evening. After learning that she could not play bingo, Diamond became hysterical and subsequently called 911. Temer requested that I trespass Diamond. Diamond was explained and issued a notice of trespass and left the property.

### Narrative

On 10/9/23 at 2101 hours, dispatch received a call from Lydia Diamond who advised she had been assaulted by the owner of the Bingo Hall. Lydia advised the she did not know the owner's name but that he got in her face and was very threatened by the situation.

Upon arrival I made contact with Lydia who was sitting in her vehicle in the parking lot of the above address. I first observed Lydia to be parked in the entrance for the employee parking, which was also the entrance for the dumpsters. The spot she was parked in was a lot a lined parking spot.

Lydia advised she was inside playing bingo when the owner (Garner Tremer) came up to her and got right in her face and was yelling at her to move her car. She advised she got very scared and there was no need for Garner to be so aggressive towards her. She advised once Garner yelled at her to move her car she came out to her vehicle and called Colchester Police. She advised she has had problems with Garner in the past, when asked what problems she advised she was trespassed for the above address in 2019. She advised Garner has been aggressive to her in the past and there is never a need for it. Lydia advised all of the interactions she has had with Garner have been due to her parking her car in incorrect parking spots and Garner asking her to move her vehicle. She advised she is handicap and the handicap spots are always full and she can't walk far so she has to park close to the building. While talking to Lydia she advised she did not want anything to happen with this situation she just wanted to go home. I advised Lydia if coming to the above address was causing her so much stress and discomfort than she could stop going to the above address. As soon as I mentioned this, Lydia put her car in reverse and started to drive away.

Corporal Jones went inside and spoke to Garner who advised he got to Bingo that night and observed Lydia's vehicle to be in the employee parking and blocking the way to the dumpsters. Garner advised Lydia was playing bingo at a table in the corner when she sat across the table from her and advised her she needed to move her vehicle. Garner advised as soon as she started to put up a fuss he called one of his other employees over to sit next to Lydia due to past involvements he wanted someone else present. He advised Lydia stated she would move her car after the game she was playing. He allowed Lydia to keep playing but insisted she move her car from where it was parked. He advised Lydia finished the game she was playing and ripped up her bingo board and then left the above address.

I spoke with the employee Garner had sit next to Lydia while talking to her, Katherine Brown advised she sat next to Lydia while Garner was asking her to move her vehicle. Katherine advised Lydia was being disgruntle at first and advised she did not have to move it due to being handicap. Lydia eventually advised she would move her car after the game she was playing. Katherine advised she and Garner left Lydia's table and allowed her to continue playing the game she was on. Katherine advised the entire time Garner was talking to Lydia he was approximately 4 feet from her and had a very calm voice and was not being threatening at all.

I spoke to Lynn Chamberlain who advised she was sitting at the table next to where Lydia was sitting when she was asked to move her vehicle. Lynn advised Lydia was being uncooperative when she was first asked to move her car even though Garner was being very calm and asking her nicely. Lynn advised Garner told Lydia she needed to move her car due to where it was parked and then left her table allowing her to continue the game she was playing. Lynn advised Lydia finished her game then ripped up her bingo boards and left the building.

Garner advised he had video of the incident and was able to play it for Corporal Jones and I. After viewing the video it is clear to see, Garner sat down across the table to Lydia had a brief conversation with her. He then called Katherine to come sit down at the table to be present for the conversation. At one point Garner stands up and advises the bingo caller to stop announcing, he advised he did this so others in the building could her the conversation he was having with Lydia. He advised he did this in case Lydia wanted to press charges he would have multiple witnesses.


