The Vermont Department of Health (Health) and Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) have reviewed the results of recent indoor air sampling for PCBs at North Country Uhs #22b.

An applicable Vermont School Action Level was exceeded.

Sampling details and temporary occupancy options are outlined in the attached letter. We recognize there is a lot of information in this letter. Staff from Health, DEC, and Agency of Education (AOE) would like to meet with you to discuss the results and temporary occupancy options for your school. Please let us know as soon as possible which day(s) and time(s) work for you by emailing me and SOV.PCBSampling@vermont.gov.

An overview of next steps for addressing PCB source(s) is also attached. More details about next steps and timeline will follow in a letter from DEC.
