Narrative

On February 7, 2019, at approximately 0833 hours, I responded to the area of N. Prospect St. and Loomis St. for a possible vandalism complaint. Dispatch advised that the caller, _____, stated she found a Patriot Front sticker affixed to a building and was awaiting an officer.

Upon arrival _____ showed me the sticker (see below photographs) which was affixed to the Plexiglas front of a Little Library's on N. Prospect St. by Loomis Street. _____ advised that she walked to work the day before and did not observe the sticker, at approximately 0830 hours, but did observe it this morning while walking by.

It appeared as if someone had already attempted to remove the sticker as the edges were pulled up. Due to the condensation on the sticker, it was saturated with moisture, it would not be viable to attempt to fingerprint.

I conferred with Sgt. Nadeau about taking the door off the Little Library to seize it and dry it out for possible prints, and it was decided that I would attempt to remove the sticker without damaging the door, which I was able to do so. This incident is changed to a suspicious event as there was no damage to the door once the sticker was removed.

I did not observe any video cameras in the area affixed to any residences.

It should be noted that Cpl. Seller took another similar complaint downtown and he e-mailed Det. Chenette about both incidents as he was investigating previous postings of Patriot Front fliers and stickers.

At approximately 1530 hours, I spoke with the owner of the Little Library, _____ on the phone as she called in about seeing the sticker. _____ stated that she noticed the sticker on Tuesday (February 5, 2019) when she took the recycles out and her husband had tried to peel it off before she realized what the organization was.

- 1) On 2-6-19 I was assigned a series of incidents involving adhesive fliers and stickers being affixed to specific community organizations and City property by the “Patriot Front”, a known Nationalist organization. The cases were linked in the Valcour system. A press release was issued.
- 2) On 2-7-19, I conducted a video canvass for all five reported locations. At 241 N. Winooski Avenue, the 99 Asian Market video only showed the parking lot and did not reach across the street. Doolan's Auto reported they are not able to view their video but it only captures their business entry, which is across the street from the victim location.
- 3) 255 S. Champlain St. confirmed they do not have video.
- 4) There was no video in the area of the Loomis / Henry St. Little Free Library.
- 5) For the posting on the 100 Bank St. newspaper dispenser outside the Burlington Free Press, I confirmed the video from People's Bank did project across the street from the entrance, but the quality was poor due to the distance. The window of opportunity for that posting was substantial, as the Free Press believed the poster appeared the morning of the February 5th. The act was likely done at night and video from the bank at that time, given the distance and lighting, was not viable.
- 6) At 188 N. Prospect Street, surveillance video was obtained showing the entrance and roadway from sun-up when the video was usable though the morning until the poster was discovered affixed to their sign. The sign itself was out of view of the camera. I reviewed the video on 2-11-19 and saw no persons walk up to the main entrance during the 5 hour time period provided. There is heavy traffic at times on S. Prospect Street, both vehicle and pedestrian. A synagogue representative provided a still frame of two individuals walking by and labeled the photo “people of interest” who appeared to exit a pickup truck.

However, due to the amount of foot traffic observed and the poor quality of the photo, there is no reason to believe the two individuals were involved. Another capture of a light-colored pickup truck passing by is also unidentifiable and likely not connected. Additionally, information from the separate incidents suggest the postings were all made at night.

- 7) On 2-8-19, a rally was held at City Hall Park for community solidarity. A tan pickup truck circled the area and two male occupants yelled, "Trump 2020, Woo!" from the window. A Connecticut registration obtained from a bystander was not accurate. There is no way to tell if this truck could have been the one that passed by the Synagogue.
- 8) On 2-11-19, I was contacted by a Source of Information (SOI) who provided information on the Patriot Front group and their activity. I passed the information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 9) On 2-11-18, the Burlington Free Press reported on a small demonstration by a handful of masked Patriot Front Members that occurred that weekend in City Hall Park in Burlington. A video of the group was posted to the Patriot Front, www.bloodandsoil.org website. After these incidents, which occurred just short of a year later, the website was updated and boasted of coordinated protests around the country, specifically referencing Vermont. A collage of pictures included banners on bridges and groups with Patriot Front flags in different States. There were no pictures labeled Vermont.
- 10) None of the structures the posters and stickers were placed on incurred any monetary damage, aside from the time of the property owners to remove them. However, the locations of the placements were concerning as they were put on or near organizations that promote diversity and inclusivity, which would cause a reasonable person who is a member or sympathizer with those places to feel threatened.
- 11) After conference with the Chittenden County State's Attorney, there is no crime to prosecute at this time and the reports are considered bias incidents. This report was forwarded to the Office of the Executive Director and Attorney General for bias incident tracking. These incidents are considered closed.

On the above date and time, I took a vandalism call at the Marketplace Garage.

Upon arrival, I spoke with garage staff [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] advised that a passing motorist saw the banner "just go up" and notified the staff. [redacted] took a photo of the banner at approximately 0953, according to the time stamp on her phone, while [redacted] went to the fifth floor of the garage and cut down the banner. [redacted] advised there was no damage to the garage itself. [redacted] stated that those who put up the banner would have done so sometime between 0900 and when the photo was taken. Both [redacted] and [redacted] stated they didn't see anyone suspicious in the area.

I took the banner taking an additional photo of the banner before tagging it into property to be destroyed.

Given the information Sgt. Labrecque had dispatch pull video surveillance of the Marketplace Garage. Cameras capture three individuals dressed in dark jackets, face mask, tan pants, with the "Flag of the Green Mountain Boys" on their jacket sleeves, enter the garage from the Bank Street car entry point at approximately 0925. It appears from the video that the come off South Winooski Ave West bound on Bank Street before entering.

Sgt. Labrecque's report attached describes the video in detail that he viewed with dispatch.

I canvased the UPS store but did not view any cameras outside the building towards South Winooski. City Market loss prevention was not at the store for video footage of cameras outside their building to see if they cut through their lot. I will be following up on Monday. Simon's employee at the time did not know how to view the footage but stated they didn't think cameras reached the other side of the street either towards Bank or South Winooski Ave. I'll follow up on Monday with Handy.

Sergeant Labrecque Report

On the above date and time I was advised that at the time unknown suspect(s) had hung a large banner from the south side of the top floor of the Market Place Parking Garage. The banner stated "Not Stolen Conquered" Patriotfront US (An outline of the USA colored blue was in between the Not Stolen and Conquered). A passer by had observed the banner and alerted Parking Garage Staff who had then cut the banner down. Parking Garage Staff then contacted BPD. We did not receive any calls from the general public about the banner.

Officer LaCouture responded and spoke with the Parking Garage Staff. With the help of Dispatchers Simays, Lorrain and Hayes we were able to observe (3) males dressed in tan pants, black or dark blue jackets, black balaclavas, mirrored sunglasses, black baseball hats. Two of the males had brown military style boots on the third had black boots. They all had a Vermont Green Mountain Boys Flags patches on the arms of their coats and various insignia on the black ball caps. Two of the males carried back packs and the third held a cellphone and appeared to be filming the incident.

At approximately 0925 hours the males make their way from the Bank Street entrance to the center tower and up the stairs and out onto the top deck of the parking garage. They run to the south side that is closest to S Winooski Ave and overlooks the Handy's garage parking lot. The males with the backpacks produce the banner and weighted milk cartons and rope from the back packs as the third films with the cell phone. They anchor the banner using the rope and weighted milk cartons and place the banner over the wall. The males then flee back to the center tower and down the stairs and exit on the first floor at approximately 0937 hours. The three males then flee east up the sidewalk/alleyway on the north side of Handy's Garage and run across S Winooski Avenue and start across the church lawn north towards Buell Street. At this point one male stops quickly, looks toward Pearl St and appears to duck and flinch. The male then flees south across the lawn towards S Winooski Ave. The other two males hesitate then follow the first male. They can be seen running across the lawn and out of view.

I have Ofc. LaCouture checking cameras at Simon's and City Market for more video of the males to help attempt to determine where they were headed. It does appear they were headed east on Buell St before making the sudden change in direction. Ofc. LaCouture was unable to secure and footage from those outlets but will follow up again on Monday.

There was no damage to the parking structure, the banner was photographed and tagged into evidence. Photos of the video stills were taken and added to the incident.

- Obtained video from the Laundry mat and the YMCA, both on S. Union St. Video shows the POI's travel northbound in a silver/grey Saturn Ion (Model year 2003-2007) on S. Union St. to the laundry mat, and then park on the northwest corner of the building in the parking lot.
- POI's leave the parking lot and travel northbound on S. Union St. past Buell St. Suspects all wearing tan pants, black jackets, backpacks.
