Narrative:

Report of Trooper Stephen DiGregorio,

On 6/6/20 at approximately 1330 hours, Williston Dispatch advised me of a suspicious case at 168 Main Street, Cambridge. Dispatch advised the complainant [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]) called to advise there was a Patriot Front sticker on the side of the Farm Store.

I responded to the above address and met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was waiting outside the store and told me that he and [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]) observed the sticker on the side of the building. The sticker was originally located on an electrical box on the North side of the building. The sticker had since been removed from the building by [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] to retrieve the sticker so that it could be photographed. The sticker was red, white, and blue. The sticker was in the shape of a flag and had a QR code printed on it. There were no words. The sticker was photographed, along the place it was found.

While investigating this incident two more stickers were located nearby. One was on a sign post at 168 Main. This sticker stated "United we stand patriotfront.us". The third was located on a sign near where one would cross the street. This sticker was identical to the original sticker located by [REDACTED]. Each location and sticker was photographed before being removed.

I contacted Det. Corporal Cremona of the VIC to notify him of my findings. Det. Corporal Cremona requested I send an email to him with locations, photos, and if they were removed or not. The email below was sent at 1520 hours.

"Darryl,

On Saturday 6/6/20 at approximately 1330 hours VSP Williston was notified of a Patriot Front sticker. The sticker was affixed to an electrical box, located on the outside of a coffee shop at 168 Main Street, Cambridge. This address is also known at 168 S Vermont 108.

The sticker was removed by the complainant [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]) prior to my arrival. The first two photos are of the building where it was located, and the third is of the actual sticker.

A second sticker was located while I was following up. It was affixed to a pole near a parking area for the coffee shop. That was photographed and then removed by myself.

Trooper Twamley located an additional sticker, at a crosswalk sign approximately 20 yards from the first two stickers. It was photographed by her and removed. I'll will request she send the photos your way.
