Narrative:

On 7-1-20 at approximately 1119 hours dispatch advised of a report of "patriot front" grafitti at the Waterbury Dam. Shortly thereafter I received a call from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at the Dept. of Energy Conservation who advised that the engineer who discovered the grafitti, [REDACTED] was on scene and would be able to show me the area. Upon arrival I met with [REDACTED] who advised that he discovered the vandalism at approximately 1100 on 6-30-20 however he did not report it because he did not know the significance of Patriot Front. It was only today that another coworker told him the meaning of the grafitti and [REDACTED] reported it to his supervisor.

[REDACTED] showed me the vandalism which consisted of a stenciled "patriotfront.us" with a patriot front symbol and a stenciled "United we Stand" also with a patriot front symbol. Both statements were written on a cement wall that serves as a buttress to the dam. The grafitti is not visible from the lake. [REDACTED] believes he last saw the buttress clean at some point on the afternoon of Thursday 6-25-20. I took pictures of the grafitti and looked for other signs of vandalism. There were no paint cans or other obvious pieces of evidence in the area. There are no cameras on the dam and there are multiple ways to access the area.

I reported my findings to Sgt. Campagne who was in touch with JTTF.

Since the date of the incident I have been forwarded numerous tips about possible suspects. I was advised by JTTF to stand down as they are investigating the incident.
